ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION [NONSTOCK CORPORATION]  
OF  
**RED WIGGLER FOUNDATION, INC.**

**FIRST:** The undersigned, William Easley Woodroof, whose address is 25214 Peachtree Road, Clarksburg, Maryland 20871, being at least eighteen years of age, does hereby form a corporation under the laws of the State of Maryland.

**SECOND:** The name of the corporation is Red Wiggler Foundation, Inc.

**THIRD:**

The nature of the business or purposes to be conducted or promoted is to engage in any lawful act or activity for which corporations may be organized under the General Corporation Law of Maryland and is to offer community training activities and social opportunities to consumers having a developmental disability.

**FOURTH:** The street address of the principal office of the corporation in Maryland is 25214 Peachtree Road, Clarksburg, Maryland 20871.

**FIFTH:** The name and street address of the resident agent of the corporation in Maryland is: William Woodroof, 25214 Peachtree Road, Clarksburg, Maryland 20871.

**SIXTH:** The corporation shall have no authority to issue stock.

**SEVENTH:** The number of directors of the corporation shall be seven which number may be increased or decreased pursuant to the bylaws of the corporation. The names of the ~~Directors~~ directors who shall act until the first meeting or until their successors are duly chosen and qualified are: William Woodroof, Dorinda Thibeau, David Sauer, Sean Campbell, Charles Joseph, Ceçelia Morgan, and Rana Crystal.

**EIGHTH:** This corporation is organized exclusively for one or more of the purposes as specified in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future tax code.

**NINTH:** The period of duration of this corporation is perpetual.

**TENTH:** The classes, rights, privileges, qualifications, and obligations of members of this corporation shall be voted upon and ratified in Bylaws of the Corporation.

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**ELEVENTH:** Upon dissolution of this corporation, its assets remaining after payments or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.

No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and this corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in, any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.

No part of the net earnings of this corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that this corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions to furtherance of the purposes set forth in these articles.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, this corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (1) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or (2) by a corporation contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code.
